Bid to upgrade all healthcare facilities

THE government has set a comprehensive plan to upgrade all healthcare facilities nationwide, Prime Minister Ibrahim Mahlab said in a press statements yesterday.

While paying a visit to the National Heart Institute, Mahlab said that the plan would also include a manpower development process to all healthcare workers.

Speaking to reporters, Mahlab said the government is keen on developing all health institutes across the nation, including the National Cancer Institute

and offer high quality services to citizens at affordable prices.

Mahlab also called for upgrading university hospitals and medical insurance system that benefits 7 million citizens.

He added that the government is working at the current stage on developing health, education and cleanness files, citing some progress in these domains.
