

Liver disease treatment protocols presented

DR GAMAL Esmat, Professor of Haepatology and Endemic Medicine at Cairo University will present the results of the abstract entitled "High Virologic Response Rate in Egyptian Patients Afflicted with Hepatitis C Virus (HCV)-Genotype 4 and Treated with Ravidasir and Sofosburvir, Results of a Large Multicentre Phase Three Registrational Trial", at the 2015 meeting of the American Association for the Study of Liver Diseases, in San Francisco, USA. The meeting will be held from November 13 to 17.





The oral presentation will take place on Monday, November 15 at the Moscone West Convention Centre in San Francisco, CA at 3:45 pm.

According to the Ministry of Health and Population, the aforementioned meeting is important because up to 8000 physicians specialised in liver diseases are due to attend it to discuss the protocols and guidelines of HCV and other liver disease treatment.

German team performs kidney transplants

DR TAREK el-Gamal, Dean of the School of Medicine, Assiut University, noted that a German medical team from Martin Luther University, had arrived to conduct a number of kidney transplant surgeries at Al-Raghi Hospital in Assiut, Upper Egypt. Dr Hisham Mokhtar, Director of the Hospital, pointed out that the German team's visit is in keeping with an agreement signed by the Assiut and Martin Luther Universities, aimed at promoting co-operation between them. The agreement includes monthly visits by the German medical team to perform 10 kidney transplant operations for hospital patients in Assiut.
