EGYPTAIR Medical Services moving ahead with overhaul plan

EGYPTAIR Medical Services is moving ahead with its upgrade and restructuring plan to improve performance and offer best services to its clients, its chairman Adel Mazrou' said.

The company has finished its overhaul of the intensive care unit (ICU) which is aimed at improving its efficiency to protect patients during their treatment at EGYPTAIR Hospital.

"Despite the upgrade's high costs, we are only looking to offer the best medical services to the hospital's patients," Mazrou' said.


Earlier this month, EGYPTAIR Medical Services started to use a new technology to monitor drug stores and their operation at the hospital so as to rationalise consumption.

Mazrou' ordered the company's IT

department to set up a computer software that can monitor and control the circulation of drugs, starting from their entry to the company's stores until they are administered to patients.

Chairman Mazrou' said that the main goal of such a move is to rationalise the consumption of drugs. "Reducing the consumption of drugs will not only benefit EGYPTAIR Hospital, but EGYPTAIR Holding Company and its nine subsidiaries as well," he added.

EGYPTAIR Medical Services started out by offering its services only to EGYPTAIR employees and their families. Later on its services were extended to cover all civil aviation field workers. Now it offers medical services to the public, healthcare medical insurance companies and to medical tourism programmes.
