

WHO: 13,000 people living with AIDS in Egypt (Al Shorouq, Dec. 25)

The World Health Organization in Egypt has urged persons at high risk for an HIV infection to get tested at one of the 18 medical centers available nationwide. The organization revealed that about 13,000 patients are living with HIV/AIDS in Egypt, noting that the number of cases identified annually increased by 25%-35% thanks to updated HIV/AIDS diagnosis strategies and raised awareness of the disease.
