

Universal healthcare system employees to receive higher wages; hiring process to begin in March

As many as 21 medical centers in Port Said are ready for the universal healthcare system, with 896 doctors receiving training on the new system and 8,000 families (40,000 people) added to the plan. Ten hiring committees were formed to choose from the 7,500 applicants who seek to join the healthcare system. Those selected are set to receive higher wages and take part in better training programs.
