Universal healthcare system: 6 categories of people entitled to fee-free services

The universal healthcare authority has revealed the six categories eligible for free health coverage. The categories include those who are receiving financial assistance from the government, individuals with disabilities who are unemployed, children who live in orphanages, senior citizens who live in nursing homes, prisoners, long-stay patients in psychiatric hospitals, low-income households, individuals with special needs, and those who suffer health issues due to natural disasters. The universal healthcare system charges are estimated at 5% of the citizen's monthly income (1% from the employee and 4% from the employer).
