ACDIMA aims to make drugs worth EGP 10 bln annually

The Arab Company for Drug Industry and Medical Appliances (ACDIMA) aims to increase its medication production to EGP 10 billion per year, up from the current EGP 8.5 billion. The public drug manufacturer, which owns 18 companies, exports products worth EGP 1.1 billion, mainly to African countries. ACDIMA sales increased by 13% to EGP 8.3 billion compared to the previous year.
