

Boehringer Ingelheim debuts poultry vaccine in Egypt

Boehringer Ingelheim's animal health unit has launched a new vaccine in Egypt to guard against Marek's Disease, a contagious virus that affects poultry. Egypt is the first country in which the company is launching the vaccine. The German company spends 10 % -15% of its total sales on research and development. It is the second-largest animal health business in the world, with net sales of almost EUR 4 billion in 2018 and a presence in more than 150 markets. The company has achieved a 5% growth rate in MENA countries and Turkey.
