

MoH recalls eight asthma, gastrointestinal drugs

The health ministry has recalled seven gastrointestinal drugs made by five companies, including a public drugmaker. The companies were ordered to add cautions regarding the active ingredient Ursodeoxycholic acid to the information leaflets inside the drug packs. The recalled medications are Ursoplus, Ursofalk 250mg, Ursotwin 50mg, Levagoal 450mg, Biliver 450mg, Ursocol 250mg, and Egyurso 500mg. The ministry also recalled substandard packs of the asthma drug Bronehoterol.
