17% of Egyptians living with migraine: neurology professor (Al Shorouq, October 16)

A Cairo University neurology professor has said that migraine is generally considered a disabling disease that can significantly reduce the quality of life of individuals affected by it. He added that female migraine sufferers tend to outnumber male sufferers by nearly 3 to 2. Migraine cases reached 17.3% in Egypt while they hit 7.1% and 7.7% in Saudi Arabia and Jordan respectively.
