

Pharmacists' Syndicate, Chamber of Commerce threaten to boycott 13 drugs over profit margin cuts

The Pharmacists' Syndicate and the Chamber of Commerce's Pharmacists' Division have called for an urgent meeting with the health minister and the head of the Central Administration for Pharmaceutical Affairs to reconsider the decision to reduce pharmacies' profit share in some drugs from 25% to 20%. Meanwhile, 13 Pharmacists' Syndicate branches have decided to boycott 13 drugs manufactured by companies that applied the profit share cut decision.
