3 Egyptians selected winners in Startupper of the year 2016 launched by Total in Egypt

Three Egyptians entrepreneurs won the title of "Startupper of the Year 2016 by Total" for their innovative projects that show ability to achieve economic and social growth. The challenge launched by Total companies in 34 African countries simultaneously aim to discover creative entrepreneurs and support them to establish non-conventional projects which affect society.

The first, second, and third winner projects received financial awards worth EGP 160,000, EGP 90,000, and EGP 70,000 in a row, as well as individual coaching provided by Total Egypt.
