5 Egyptian teams to compete in Shell Eco-marathon in Qatar

Five Egyptian university teams will compete in the Shell Eco-marathon (SEM) Asia-Pacific and Middle East 2025 regional competition, taking place for the first time in the Middle East at the Lusail International Circuit in Doha, from 8-12 February.

This year marks the 40th anniversary of the SEM, a global academic programme challenging students to design, build, and test ultra-energy-efficient vehicles. Egyptian universities have participated since 2013, with hundreds of students benefiting from the programme. Previous Egyptian teams have won awards including the Innovation, Safety, and Communication Awards.

Dalia Elgabry, Vice Presi-



dent and Country Chair for Shell Egypt, said: "At Shell, we are committed to empowering young innovators and driving sustainable solutions for a cleaner energy future. The Shell Eco-marathon embodies this mission by encouraging students to collaborate, persevere,

and innovate."

Past participants Menna and Zeyad, from Cairo and Helwan Universities respectively, highlighted the programme's impact. They stated: "This competition pushes us to innovate beyond limits and prepares us for real-world challenges in energy and sustainability."
