Egypt to host EGYPS second edition

Egypt International Petroleum show 2018 (EGYPS) will be held from 12 to 14 February at the New Cairo Exhibition Centre.


It will be the first international event to be held in the new centre in support of Egypt's strategic position as a vital industry centre.

In the same context, EGYPS 2018 to be held under the patronage of his Excellency President Abdel Fattah Al-Sisi, President of Egypt, spearheaded by the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources and organized by DMG Events' global energy and ACG-ITE.
