

Pharmacies' profit share in relation to 179 drugs drops, Pharmacists' Syndicate threatens to boycott drugmakers

Pharmacists' Syndicate branches in Sharkia, Gharbia, and Port Said have announced the halt of sales of Voltaren, threatening to boycott all Novartis Pharma's products unless it reverses the decision to cut pharmacies' profit share in the popular painkiller. Some drugmakers, including Novartis, have reduced pharmacies' profit share in their products from 25% to 20%.
