MoH approves production of 40 vital medications

SEDICO, a health ministry subsidiary, will start producing about 40 new medications after renovating its plant that was damaged by fire two years ago, at a total cost of EGP 100 million. The drugmaker added five production lines that can produce 20 million vials and 60-90 million ampoules per year. The company said it will focus on manufacturing vital medications such as Insulin H Mix, Epoetin, Somatropin, Sedonase, and Dexamethasone.
