## DMG Events Bring 'The Big 5' to Egypt's \$335 Billion Construction Market

Over the last few years, the exhibition has been held in a number of countries beyond the UAE, including Saudi Arabia, Morocco, and Kenya, becoming the largest and most influential go-to exhibition for the construction sector in the Middle East. Like other events in The Big 5 portfolio, The Big 5 Construct Egypt will place significant focus on the quality of its content. For businesses, the show will feature the Hosted Buyers Program and free 1-on-1 business meetings with industry leaders and decision makers.
